Please also include why you wish to serve on the Board and what you will bring to the position and to the Board as a whole. This information will aid in the interview and recommendation process.

Applications will be accepted through Sunday April 7th and candidates will be interviewed over the phone by two members of the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee will consist of 6 active members of the HS PTO General Membership, two parents from Glen Head, Glenwood Landing and Sea Cliff. One parent from each School will serve to vet potential Candidates and one parent from each school shall serve to review applications and to vote for Nominees. The Committee will be chaired by the HS PTO past President.
